- 2. What are the emerging functions of trade unions in the present IR context?

  Comment on the external leadership of trade unions.
- 3. Bring out the difference between legal and illegal strikes. How do IR managers deal with illegal strikes?
- 4. What are unfair labour practices? Give examples. How can victimisation of workers be prevented?
- 5. What is the difference between conciliation undertaken by conciliation officers and boards of conciliation? Mention the role of IR managers in conciliation.
- 6. When can a worker be retrenched by the management? Examine the relevant ID Act provisions and the recent amendments.
- 7. What is the typical nature of grievances in organizations? How can they be redressed effectively?
- 8. How are graduate apprentices appointed in industrial units? Comment on their terms and conditions of apprenticeship. (5×6=30 Marks)

Answer any three questions. All carry equal marks. Each answer not to exceed 1500 words:

- 9. What are standing orders? Explain the legal formalities involved in certifying standing orders. Also, examine the relevance of standing orders in the light of the emergence of new age organizations.
- 10. How is recognition of trade unions different from registration of trade unions? Explain the procedure for conducting referendum in industrial units.
- 11. What is collective Bargaining? How are collective bargaining agreements registered? Explain the scope of collective bargaining in non-unionised industries.
- 12. Do you think Industrial Disputes act promote better IR in industries? Why? Substantiate your answer by citing examples from the current scenario and your field work experience.
- Critically analyze the labour problems prevailing in public sector organizations.
   How can industrial peace be maintained in PSUs? Also, examine the scope for a National Industrial Relations policy for PSUs in India. (3×15=45 Marks)
