6. Explain the role of tripartite bodies in Indian labour administration mentioning their significant contributions.
7. Give suggestions to make the Kerala State Labour Department more efficient and professional.
8. What is the admissible rate of L.T.O. in manufacturing industries ? As an HR executive, how will you reduce the rate of excessive L.T.O ?

13. Explain the need for evolving a National social security policy for the retrenched labour force. What are the recommendations of the second National Labour Commission in this respect ?
